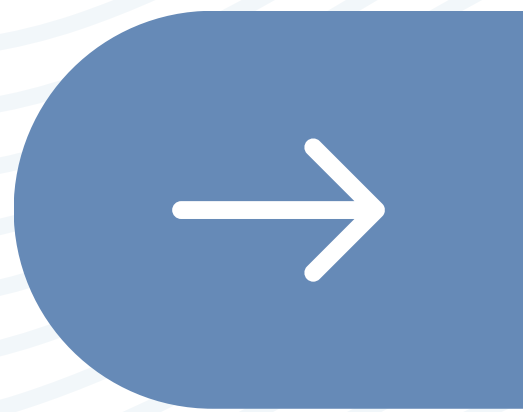

TYPES OF GASTRECTOMY: BASED ON METHOD OF RECONSTRUCTION

Billroth I Gastroduodenostomy:

Commonly used in cases where the distal portion of the stomach needs to be removed, such as in cases of peptic ulcers or gastric tumors.

Billroth II Gastrojejunostomy:

Used when the removal of the distal stomach is necessary, and a direct connection to the duodenum is not feasible or advisable. not suitable for anastomosis, as it bypasses the duodenum and connects the stomach directly to the jejunum.

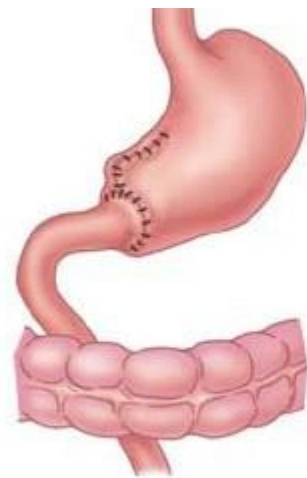
Roux-en-Y Gastrojejunostomy:

Frequently used in weight loss surgery (Roux-en-Y gastric bypass) as it restricts food intake and alters the digestive process, resulting in weight loss.

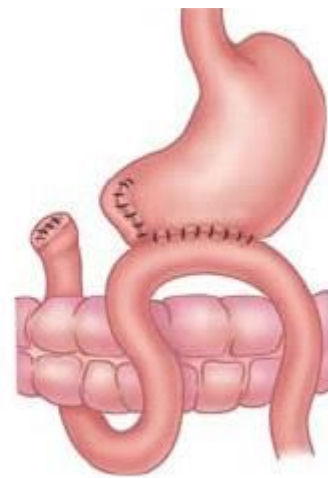
