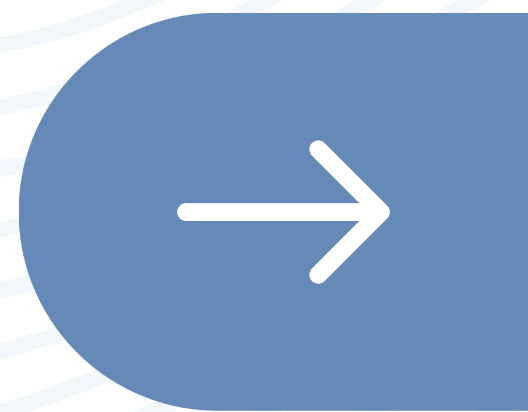

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TRIAGE

This term is derived from the French verb “trier” meaning “to sort” or “to choose”. It’s the process by which patients are classified according to the type and urgency of their conditions to get the Right patient to the Right place at the Right time with the Right care provider.



RED CRITERIA (TRIAGE PROTOCOL)

- ***Airways- Obstructed/Threatened–Stridor/Noisy breathing.***
- ***Breathing- RR<10 or >24*, SPO2< 95%.***
- ***Circulation- Radial Pulse- Present/Absent, PR<50 or >100/min, SBP<90mmHg, Capillary refill >2sec.***
- ***Disability(AVPU)GCS- Responding only to pain or Unconscious***



YELLOW CRITERIA

- ***Airways- Patent airway***
- ***Breathing- RR-10- 24/min, SPO2>95%***
- ***Circulation- PR<50 or >100/min, SBP>90mmHg, Capillary refill <2sec***
- ***Disability(AVPU)GCS- Not Alert but Responding only to verbal command***



GREEN CRITERIA

- ***Airways- Patent airway***
- ***Breathing- RR-10- 24/min, SPO2>95%***
- ***Circulation- PR<50 or >100/min, SBP>90mmHg, Capillary refill <2sec.***
- ***Disability(AVPU)GCS- Alert***
